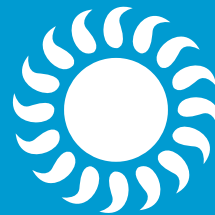

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT ROOFTOP SOLAR BEFORE I INVEST?

Before you invest in rooftop solar, you need to consider cost, reliability, warranties, and maintenance...just to name a few important topics.
