DOING GREAT THINGS TOGETHER

Coast Electric Power Association has a long history of supporting our community and giving back to our friends and neighbors. In 2018, we made some changes to our Operation Round Up program to extend our community commitment even further, all thanks to the generosity of our members.

Operation Round Up is a program that rounds up the bills of participating Coast Electric members to the nearest dollar. Contributions are used to fund programs that improve the quality of life in our communities. The program is designed to put 65% of donations into a community trust to fund grants for local charitable organizations and 10% is put into an endowment for future charitable giving. These funds are managed by the Gulf Coast Community Foundation. The remaining 25% of donations are used for residential energy assistance through the Share Your Blessings program managed by Catholic Charities of South Mississippi.

The average monthly donation per member is just fifty cents and while it may not seem like your spare change can do much, when combined with the efforts of your fellow Coast Electric members, your pennies and dimes are funding projects that improve the quality of life in our local communities. From children's organizations to environmental initiatives and so much more, we are doing great things, together.







THE COOPERATIVE DIFFERENCE

One benefit of cooperative membership is that leadership roles are filled by our members. We rely on a committee of nine Coast Electric members to serve on the Operation Round Up Community Trust Committee. These members are advocates in the community and help determine which grants will be funded to making lasting, positive impacts in our local communities.
