NOTICE OF WORK TO BE PERFORMED
IN PROXIMITY TO HIGH VOLTAGE POWER LINES**

Instructions for form submission

Once the form has been received, a representative of Coast Electric will contact you within 48 hours to schedule a meeting to review the form and your activity/work.

I. SCOPE

This application is in accordance with Sections 45-15-1, *et seq.*, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended. No one is permitted to perform work or any activity that could be reasonably expected to place a person, equipment, tool, or material within ten (10) feet of any high voltage overhead line during the performance of the activity. The required ten-foot clearance cannot be provided by movement of the high voltage overhead line through strain impressed, by attachments, or otherwise.

If anyone wishes to perform any activity within ten (10) feet of a high voltage overhead line within the service area of Coast Electric Power Association ("Coast Electric"), then they must promptly notify Coast Electric, in writing, on a form provided by Coast Electric, and must not perform the work until mutually satisfactory arrangements have been made between Coast Electric and the person or business responsible for performing the work, to deter contact with the high voltage overhead lines.

Coast Electric will provide a written cost estimate for providing any necessary safety arrangements. If the requesting party disagrees with the reasonableness of the cost estimate or believes that it calls for more work than is reasonably necessary to protect those working in close proximity to the high voltage overhead lines, then the requesting person has the following options: (1) Coast Electric may be directed to commence work under protest, with the requesting party paying the utility for the work in accordance with the cost estimate, but the requesting party will be entitled to seek recovery of all or part of the money paid to Coast Electric in binding arbitration in accordance with the procedures in Sections 11-15-

101 through 11-15-143 of the Mississippi Code of 1972.; or (b) prior to directing the performance of the work, the requesting party may submit to binding arbitration, to resolve the issues of reasonableness and necessity of the cost, and the description of the work to be performed by Coast Electric under its written cost estimate.

Coast Electric will commence arrangements within five (5) working days of a mutual agreement, notice to proceed under protest, or a decision of the arbitrators.

Requesting Party hereby requests Coast Electric to confer with Requesting Party or Requesting Party’s representative at the Location to ascertain the type of work activity that will take place and further if safety measures need to be taken by either Requesting Party or Coast Electric. Coast Electric will give Requesting Party a written cost estimate for safety arrangements to deter contact with onsite power lines. Requesting Party

agrees not to perform such functions or activities until mutually satisfactory arrangements as provided by Section 45-15-9 have been made to deter contact with Coast Electric's lines.

Nothing contained in this Notice diminishes or affects the obligations imposed upon Coast Electric under Section 45-15-1, *et seq.*, or under existing laws, and this Notice shall not be construed as a waiver of the Requesting Party's or Coast Electric's rights under law.

Only after all requested information is supplied by the Requesting Party will Coast Electric deem Requesting Party's information to constitute proper Notice of work to be performed.
